MAKE YOUR OWN USHIDASHI

MATERIALS FOR THIS PROJECT:

- -Play-doh or air-dry clay
- -Aluminum foil
- -Cardboard or paper
- -Found objects
- -Q-tip or pencil with eraser

TO CREATE USHIDASHI:

- 1) Form clay into flat circle about one inch thick. Make designs with your finger or find objects around the house to press into your clay. Remove objects, leaving an impression in your mold.
- 2) Take a piece of foil larger then your clay mold and fold in half. Place over the top of your mold and lightly press down. Use a q-tip, or the eraser end of a pencil to get into the crevices.
- 3) Carefully lift your foil from your mold and see your design in the foil! Tape or glue the edges of your USHIDASHI to a piece of paper or cardboard to display.
